Requirements upon Approval

- 1. Welcome an annual visit from the Home Missions Director and/or Committee member.
- 2. Pastor/leader complete quarterly report forms and submit to the Home Missions office.
- 3. Treasurer/Secretary complete quarterly report forms and submit to the Home Missions office
- 4. Participate in monthly calls with the AFLC Home Missions Director.
- 5. Encourage your leaders to attend one of our training sessions (February retreat in Mesa, AZ, workshop in conjunction with SIT, or a special church planting convention with the Home Mission Director).
